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

Camper Development Program

CAMPER WAITER

Campers who have COMPLETED THE NINTH GRADE in school and have PASSED their FOURTEENTH birthday are eligible to become camper waters. They will follow a regular activity schedule, modified to their see group and complementing camper waiter duties.

STAFF-AIDE

Campers who have COMPLETED THEIR SOPHOMORE YEAR (10th grade) and have celebrated their FIFTEENTH birthday are eligible to become Stall Aides. Stall Aides are assigned to various camp departments or program specialists. I.e., arts and crafts athletics, enterfront, drametics, camp office infilmery, dance, etc. These assignments may be on a permanent or rotating basis. A Staff Aide's duties include those of a camper waiter.

COUNSELOR IN TRAINING

A Counselor In-Training is a previous Lown ment camper who has completed the JUNIOR YEAR of high school (131n grade) and has PASSED his SIXTEENTH BIRTHDAY, C.I.T. s are assigned to live with a younger bunk group to help the counselors in the cabin. A study program and camper waiter duties are included in this category.
