Studies have shown that a computer is an excellent educational tool. It appeals to students of all interests and abilities; it enables teachers to tailor programs to the individual needs of their students; and it prepares students for a world in which computers are used in business, government and industry. Being exposed to the operation of a computer and its programming language can only help children in their future endeavors.

To help students in Jewish schools take advantage of the enrichment that a computer brings to a classroom, many programs have been created to teach Hebrew language and Judaica. We have purchased an Apple IIe computer with all of the accessories to give it Hebrew-English capabilities. The software that we have purchased covers many areas of Jewish life, including holidays; Hebrew vocabulary, grammar, and composition; studies on Israel and the Bible; as well as materials to aid teachers in making new programs for their students. We would like to thank the Federation for their continued support and particularly for this exciting new project.
