

# BATH HEBREWS START A DRIVE

Bath's drive for the Jewish Relief fund of \$14,000,000 planned by American Hebrews for their less fortunate peoples in the old world has begun. At a meeting at the new synagogue Sunday afternoon the Bath committee was perfected with the choice of Max Cohen, chairman; Bessie Brown, financial secretary; Morris Cohen, treasurer; Mrs. H. A. Isaacson, recording secretary; Heyman Abramson and Max Kutz, press committee.

The movement has the endorsement of President Harding, Secretary of Commerce Herbert C. Hoover and others high in authority in the United States. Gov. Percival P. Baxter, in endorsing the drive says: "There are no lines or race or religion when human beings are suffering."

Bath's quota is \$2500 of which the sum of \$550 has already been contributed by Bath Hebrews. All contributions to the fund should be sent to Morris Cohen, 147 Front street.
