

CLOTHING AND FOOD FOR JEWISH RELIEF

Bath Committee Urges Help For Suffering Jews in Other Countries

The Joint Distribution committee of the Jewish Relief Agency under sponsorship of the Maine Jewish council is conducting an urgent campaign for collection of supplies for overseas sufferers and which is deserving of the support of all. With Europe going through the grimmest years in recent history, a million and a half surviving Jews still totter on the brink of death through starvation, disease and cold. All their possessions have been looted, confiscated or destroyed by the Nazis.

Over 90 per cent of these survivors live in countries where UNRRA does not operate and, therefore, they do not receive aid from the international agency.

Items solicited include food, comfort items and medicine, household supplies and infants' and children's items of clothing. These articles may be either new or used providing they are in good condition. In addition food items also are requested.
