The 1930 census shows a William W and Nancy C Gibbs in Waltham, MA. He was age 43, born in Massachusetts, and an architect. Nancy was age 33 born in Massachusetts. They had been married for 12-13 years and had children Yvonne L, Emily, Daniel W. Jr., Patricia and Nancy C. All the children were born in Massachusetts. Sally was not born until after the census. Gibbs was listed as an architect in "general practice." His father is shown as born in Massachusetts and his mother in the "United States." Nancy's parents are shown as born in England. They lived at 17 Lord Street.

The earlier 1920 census shows the Gibbs family in Waltham with only daughter Yvonne. Daniel was shown as age 31 and Nancy as age 23. Daniel was an architect in an "Engineer's Office." They lived at 32 South Street.

This census shows a Thomas V. Alcock (age 50) also living in Waltham. He is listed as a civil engineer who had immigrated in 1891. His wife Lucy (age 54) is shown as immigrating in 1896. Both are shown as aliens. Their daughters Jessie B. and Emily A. and son Thomas R. lived with them. Jessie at 21 was a librarian.

The prior 1910 census shows Thomas V. Alcock, age 40, living in Newton, MA, with wife Lucy M., age 45. This is shown as the first marriage for both, and that they had been married for 14 years. Their children are listed as Nancy C., 13, Jessie B., 11, Emily A., 9, and Thomas R., 3. Jessie and Emily are shown as born in Vermont, and Nancy and Thomas were born in Massachusetts. Thomas and Lucy and both of their parents are shown as born in England. Thomas' occupation is shown as "draftsman" for an engineering consultant. Lucy is shown as immigrating in 1895.

The 1900 census shows Thomas V. Alcock, age 32 and wife Lucy M, age 33, living in Brookfield, VT, with children Nancy C and Jessie. Thomas is shown as born in April 1868; Lucy in September 1867, Nancy in June 1896, and Jessie in May 1898. Lucy and Thomas' ages have both been written over, as though they provided their ages and then the enumerator had to correct them based on their birth years. Lucy is shown as having given birth to 5 children, of whom 2 were still living. Lucy and Thomas are shown as having been married for 5 years. Thomas is listed as a farmer. Both are listed as immigrating in 1888.
