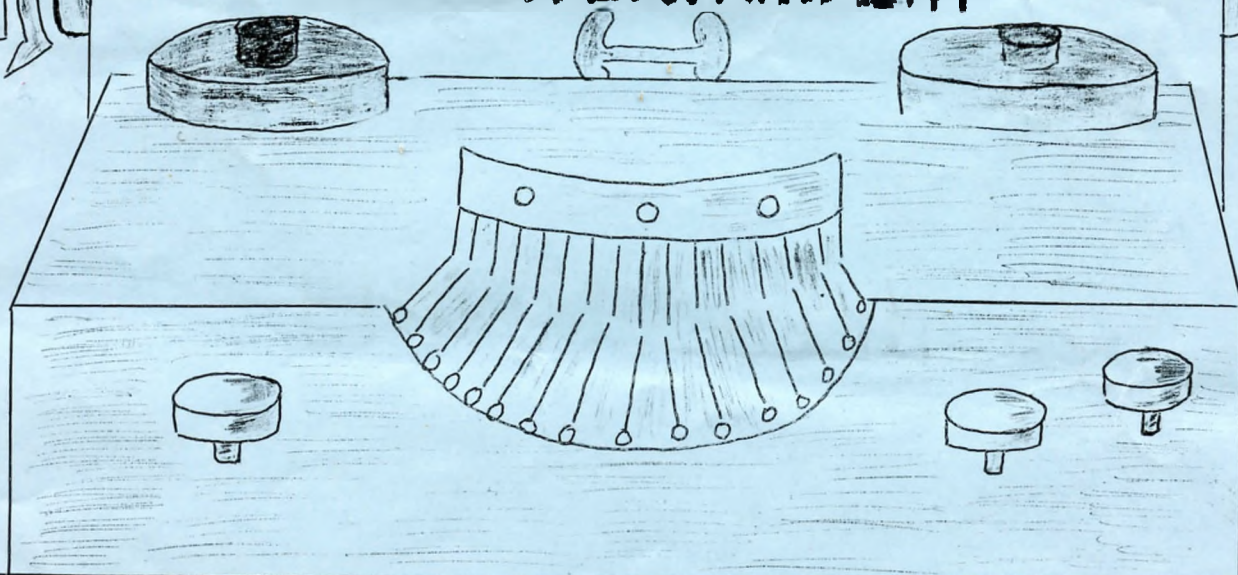

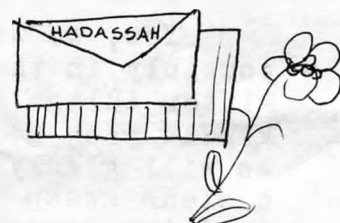

That day was May 14, 1948, at which time David Ben Gurion, then first Prime Minister of the NEW STATE about to be born read the Proclamation of Independence.
