Certificate for the use of SAMUEL [§]KRONSBURG to prove his citizenship through his father's naturalization.

I, Marion Richards, Chief Deputy Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Maine, hereby certify that it appears from the naturalization records of the District Court of the United States, Volume XIII, Page 8, Petition 2858, that one MAX KRONSBURG, formerly METEL KRONSBURG or KRONTZBERG, described therein as a subject of Russian Poland, living at 76 Monument street, Portland, Maine, born at Rouno, Russian Poland, May 18, 1872, was admitted as a citizen of the United States of America by order of said District Court on the fifth day of March A. D. 1923, and that certificate of naturalization was issued to him. The record shows that Samuel Kronsberg, son, was born at Toyzen, Russia, November 12, 1902.
