Dr. David I. Brownstone, 94, of Brighton Avenue, who practiced general dentistry and orthodontia here for many years, died early Friday morning at the Barron Center.

He was born here, a son of Morris and Dora Satskin Brownstone, attended local schools and graduated from the University of Maine at Orono.

He did his graduate work at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine and Columbia University.

During World War II, he enlisted in the Army at the age of 40 and served in Europe as a captain.

A life member of Temple Beth El, he had served as president of B'nai B'rith, was very involved in the Jewish Community Center and was a member of the American Dental Association.

Dr. Brownstone attended his class reunions at Tufts University until he was well into his 80s.

His hobbies were fishing , boating and reading.

His wife, Marjorie Cobb Brownstone, died previously.

Surviving are his wife, Marilyn, of Delray Beach, Fla.; four nephews, Robert Epstein, Arthur Silverman of New York City, Morris Silverman of Lewiston and Harold Brownstone of New Jersey; two nieces, Marjorie Feinberg of Andover, Mass., and

Marsha Browstone Green ; and 15 great-nieces and great-nephews.

A service will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at Temple Beth El, 400 Deering Ave. Rabbis Carolyn Braun and Harry Z. Sky will officiate. Burial will be in Beth El Memorial Park. Arrangements are by Abraham and Fannie Levey Funeral Home.
