I further declare that my reason for leaving all my property, both real and personal, to them and them alone, excepting such share as the law requires to be given to others, is not only because of the love I have for my sons, but with all respect due to the memory of my deceased wife, and for the great love I still bear her.

Third:- I give and bequeath to my present wife, Bessie, such share, and only such share, as she is entitled to as my widow under the laws of the State of Maine.

Fifth:- If any of my sons herein named should die before my death, only their heirs of the body shall take any part of this, my estate, and if any of my sons herein named, should die before my death without heirs of the body, his share shall be divided equally between his surviving brothers, herein named.
