

ON SHORES OF MERRYMEETING

New Colony Will Be Located

A new Jerusalem is to spring up on the shores of Merrymeeting Bay in the near future and will be in operation next summer although it will probably take several years to have the place laid out in proper form.

The firm of Brown & Sims of Boston has purchased 100 acres of land on the shore of the Bay, north from Cook's Corner, and has awarded a contract to Daniel W Bishop of this city to erect a large double house which will contain fifty rooms. This apartment hotel will be unique in construction. It will be built long, about 200 feet, and through it will run a hallway on each side of which will be rooms. On the beach near by will be erected a large cook house and dining hall for the use of guests.

It is the intention of the firm to erect about fifty cottages on the property and it is reported that the entire colony will be occupied by Hebrews of Boston and vicinity.

The colony will enjoy all modern conveniences, including hot and cold water in the hotel, the water to be pumped by a windmill from a well. An ice house and a dairy will be installed at once.

When completed the colony will be the first of its kind in Maine.
