



# Time to Pause and Reassess

Rosh Hashanah is an appropriate time for us to pause and reassess where we, as members of the Jewish community in America and the world, are headed, and what problems we face in the future.

This year, the United States is involved in the celebration of the Bicentennial of the American Revolution. As members of the Jewish community, it is important for us to be aware of the part played by Jews in the building of the United States. To this end, JWB and Jewish Community Centers are carrying out a number of Bicentennial-related programs, emphasizing the contributions that Jews and Jewish Community Centers have made to American culture and the contributions that American culture has made to Judaism.

It is fitting that now, as we are celebrating the birth of "the land of the free," the Jewish community is being called upon to welcome the new wave of Soviet Jews who have emigrated to freedom in the United States. 

### **Center Membership Accident Insurance**

Accident insurance is available to Center Members through a special group plan available through National Jewish Welfare Board. The program covers individuals in all Center activities either on or off Center premises or travels to or from Center activities. The policy covers individuals up to age 64; after age 64 coverage is available but there is an automatic Medicare deductible. Coverage is available on an individual premium. There are three plans that are available.

- 1. Covers a member from September 15, 1976 -September 15, 1977 — fee \$5.00
- Covers a member from September 15, 1976 -June 15, 1977 — fee \$3.50
- 3. Covers a member from June 15, 1977 -September 15, 1977 — fee \$2.50

This is a full accident policy and includes \$1,000 accident and medical benefit limit. There is an automatic \$10.00 deductible for all basketball injuries and there is a \$150.00 dental limit, \$1,000 accident death benefit and a \$5,000 accident dismemberment benefit.

The following activities are especially excluded from coverage: soccer, ice hockey, snow skiing, tackle football and lacrosse. If you wish to enroll in this plan, please contact the Center office for an application as soon as possible.


