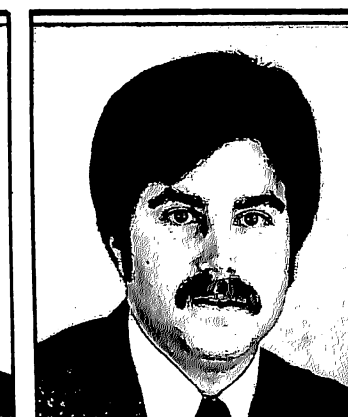

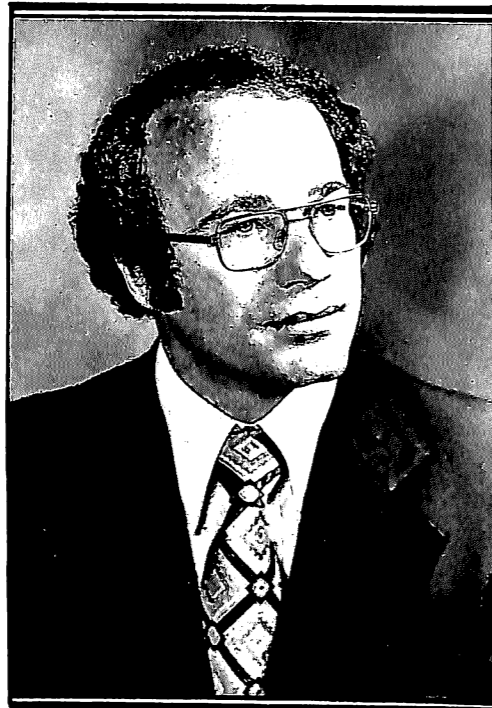

Today, we have periodic joint meetings of the Federation and the Center Executive Committees to begin a cohesive planning process for capital expenditure such as new facilities and new equipment.

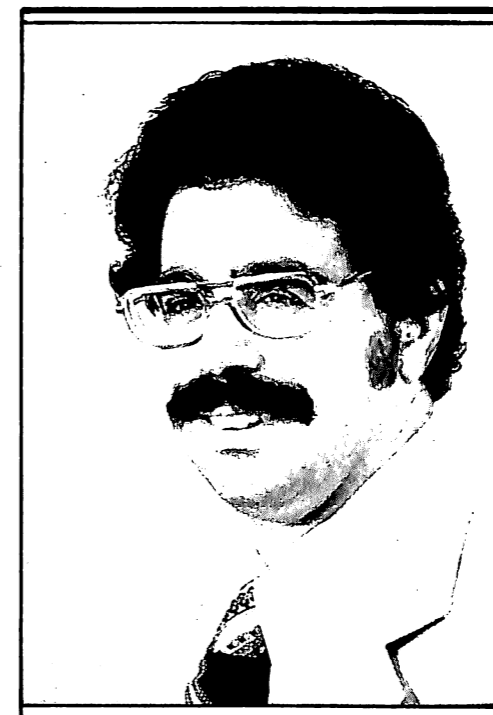

The process has begun... we are beginning to work "as one."

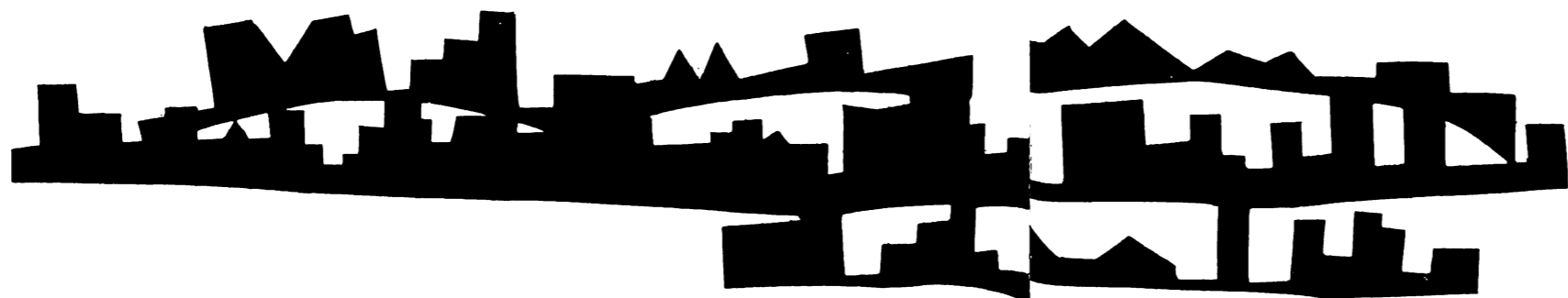

I am confident that the Center will continue to provide this Jewish community with the wide variety of programs designed to expand each member's creative talents and interests in living a more meaningful Jewish life.

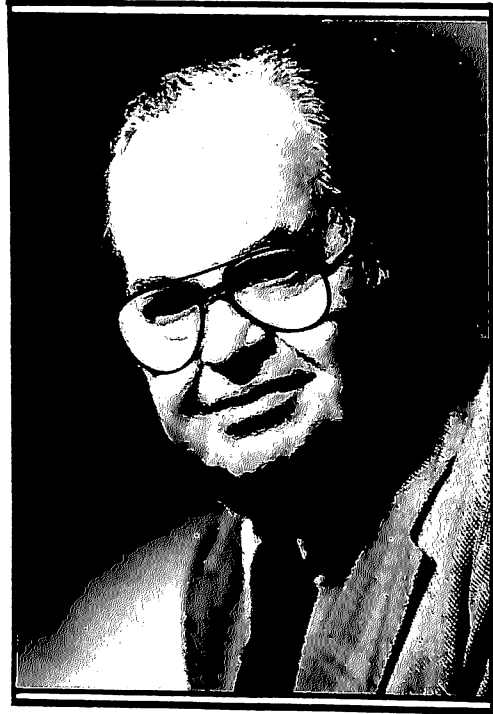

A Rosh Hashanah Message

Meant To Be A Nation of Scholars

The High Holy Days are a time for celebration and affirmation. They are also a time for assessing challenges and charting new directions.

We of the JWB family find ourselves more challenged than ever to grapple with the priorities of strengthening Jewish identity, enhancing the quality of Jewish life and deepening the relationship between North American Jewry and Israel and, indeed, with Jews throughout the world.

There is a community to build and to strengthen—whether it be civilian or military, in North and South America, Israel, Europe, and elsewhere. We in JWB see ourselves, the Jewish Community Center, Federation, and other agencies of the Jewish communal network as having unique roles in providing the leadership, services and programs so essential for a vibrant Jewish life.

The password to the future is community—the entire community working together for a common goal.

In his "Farewell Song" to the Israelites, Moses characterized us as a "dor tahapukhoth" — a generation of turn-about. The illustrious Dubner Magid illustrated this Biblical phrase in the following manner: In a European shtetl a Chassidic Rebbe was about to marry off his daughter to a son of a "baal agalah" — a cabbie. The Rebbe and the cabbie each decided that, in order not to embarrass his counterpart, each should don the professional garments of the other at the wedding. The Rebbe appeared wearing boots, a leather jacket and a cabbie's cap; the cabbie wore the ecclesiastic garments of the Rebbe. Of course each was mistaken for the other.

Israel today projects a militaristic image and appears to the world as a Spartan state. But we were really meant to be a nation of scholars. Moses, too, chided our forefathers for assuming a different role from that which G-d assigned to us.

On the local scene, the Jewish Community Center and the Jewish Federation have demonstrated their ability to mobilize their communities in cooperative efforts.

On the national scene, 17 major Jewish agencies just this past year worked together on a Holocaust materials project—a multi-agency cooperative endeavor on a scale rarely if ever before seen. The project demonstrated a practical way of how we can marshal our skills and talents most effectively and get the most out of community dollars. Inter-agency cooperation means reduced duplication of efforts and reduced competition among agencies. Now that this has been demonstrated it can be applied to future projects in American Jewish life.

On behalf of the entire JWB family, I extend warmest greetings for the New Year and pray that the year ahead may be one of peace, happiness and fulfillment.

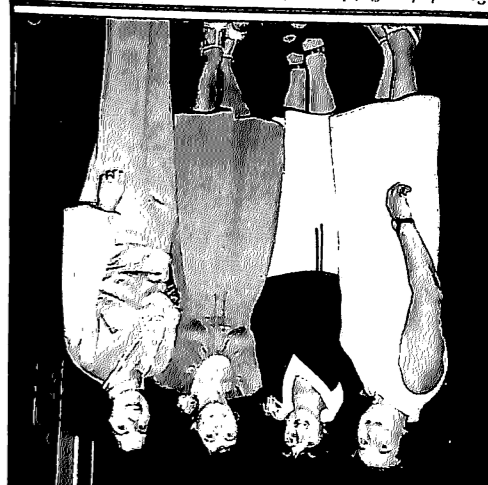

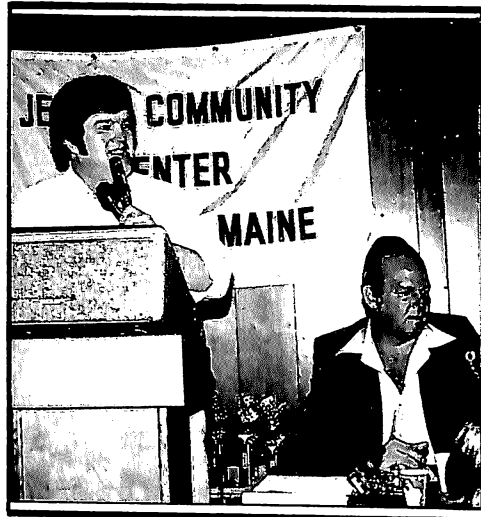

In city double elimination playoffs the team dropped its first game, 8-7, to eventual champion Press Herald, then won three straight before a second defeat.



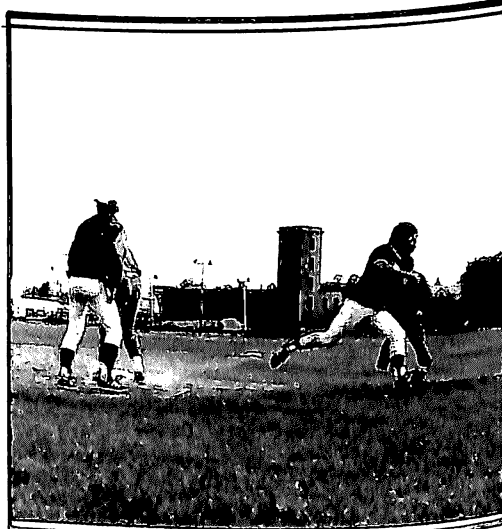
