

Copy: Recommendations of the Seating Committee

The seating committee of Congregation Shaarey Tphiloh met on April 2, 1972 and are presenting the following recommendations to the board for their consideration. These suggestions are supplemental to the original plans that was passed by the board of directors on July, 1963 when the original sale of the plush seats were presented to our congregation.

1. When a member has a plush seat for himself and his wife and his wife dies, and he remarries, he may retain the privilege of a plush seat for his new wife.

2. If any member who has paid for a plush seat or seats has resigned or has left the community and is later reinstated to membership, he shall again be entitled to a plush seat or seats without further payment.

3. Whenever possible to do so, the seating committee is authorized to use its judgment in assigning individual seats to those who have used these seats in the previous years.

4. After lengthy discussion concerning the question of transferring or assigning the use of plush seats, and considering a possible solution to the problem which might be worked out within the next year or two, the committee recommends that this coming year, we shall continue with the policy for which there is already precedent to allow members in good standing who have paid for a plush seat, to assign such seat for use during the holidays to another member or out of town guest for whom the admission fee has been paid.

All the above four recommendations are in effect provided that there are seats available in the upholstered section.
