Celebrating Henry's move to Portland, the paintings shown are recent works ranging from wanderings near his new home to visits with friends and places around the world.

Whether it's people at play or work, or islands strewn across the reaches of Casco, Penobscot or Frenchman's Bays, he uses all as elements to build his images. The subject is constructed from these individual parts and the tangible atmosphere that lies between.

Isaacs has had a varied and impressive education, including the Slade School of Art in London, the Rhode Island School of Design, and the Putney School in Vermont. Isaacs' teaching career is even more impressive and varied, with stints teaching anatomical drawing at Dartmouth, drawing and painting at the Massachusetts College of Art, and drawing at several European colleges.
