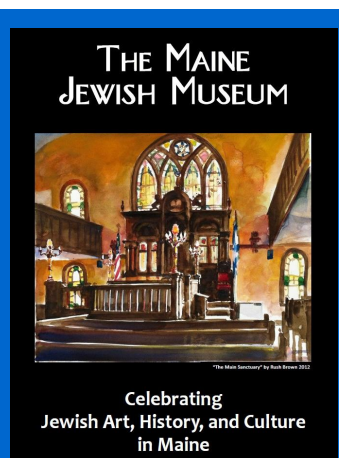

*Rabbi Dr. David Fox Sandmel is long-time interfaith activist. He has served as Director of Interreligious Engagement at ADL since 2014. From 2003-2014, he held the Crown-Ryan Chair in Jewish Studies at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago. As Judaic Scholar at the Institute for Christian & Jewish Studies in Baltimore, he managed the project that produced "**Dabru Emet: A Jewish Statement on Christians and Christianity.**" He is an editor of **Christianity in Jewish Terms** and **Irreconcilable Differences? A Learning Resource for Jews and Christians**, and is Vice-Chair of The International Jewish*
