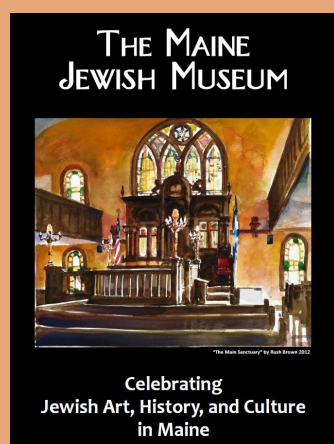

Ted and Rush are both exhibiting at the Maine Jewish Museum through July 5th.

Ted's exhibition, entitled "Musicians" and being shown in the Spiegel Gallery, is a series of paintings inspired by a performance of the All-Portland School Band and several band concerts in different districts thereafter. The school band is always on the endangered species list. Yet each year a small legion picks up the trombones of their ancestors, and with hope, fear, faith and sweat, begins the ancient human struggle to let our spirit out of its cage.

The paintings in Rush's exhibition, entitled "The Museum Paintings" and being shown in the Fineberg Family Community Room, represent a theme that has emerged throughout a career focused on the human figure, landscape and the narrative that springs forth between them. People in museums occupy a specific microcosm that is both private and public. Individuals interact with the work being displayed and with each other in ways that are social or not, and in ways that are strictly visual, relative to composition.
