**JWB Opposes Tax
 Which Could Hurt
 Gifts To Charity**

The National Jewish Welfare Board (JWB) has gone on record against proposed Federal tax changes which would adversely affect philanthropic institutions by putting a floor under itemized deductions of individuals, including those for charitable purposes. JWB not only joined with other national organizations in opposition to the tax proposal but also stated its own stand in a position paper drafted by the Public Affairs Committee and adopted by the Executive Committee, in recognition of the injury the proposed tax change might represent to the support of voluntary social welfare agencies.

Jewish Community Centers and JWB Armed Services Committees were urged by Solomon Litt, national JWB president, to take similar action and to urge that charitable institutions be excluded from the "deduction package" and that no other change be made in the tax laws which would impair the principle of contribution deductibility or which would lessen incentives to giving.

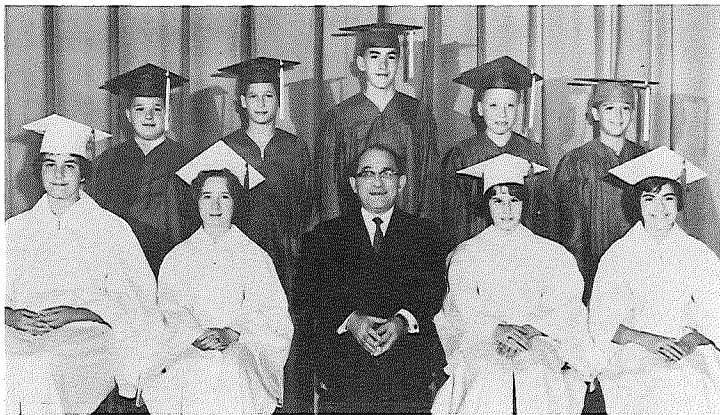
